SpagoBI 2.0 Released

The new version 2.0 of SpagoBI has been released. The main module, SpagoBI Server, offers: 5 new analytical engines, SOA architecture, SSO and SSL, many cross-platform functionalities. [Download](#) and discover the new SpagoBI Server.

SpagoBI 2009 Downloads

SpagoBI has well started the new year: 6.412 downloads at January and 6.783 downloads at February (as at the 26th), holding the 4th place in the OW2 top 10 Downloads (this information is taken from the OW2 Forge, that hosts the projects). The distribution of these 2009 downloads is as follows:
France 32.6%, Italy 16.6%, China 7.9%, Brazil 6.2%, Iran 5.0%, USA 5.0%, other 26.8%.
